A pipefitter by trade (Local 392), he erected a whimsical sculpture and submitted it in a local contest at the Cincinnati Zoo. After taking first place, one of the other workers asked him to make something for a gift...51 years later the rest is history.

George passed away in 2021, at age 80, after losing his battle with Milo Fibrosis, a blood disorder affecting the bone marrow. He left his legacy in good hands, his grandkids, Alex, Jarred, Andrew, Emily, Elena, and Anna, who are continuing the traditions of making metal sculptures of all types, using brass, copper, steel, and a variety of other metals. The unique colors are his trademark, burning in red, green, and blue colors throughout the piece
